SUMMARY OF SURVEY FINDINGS.

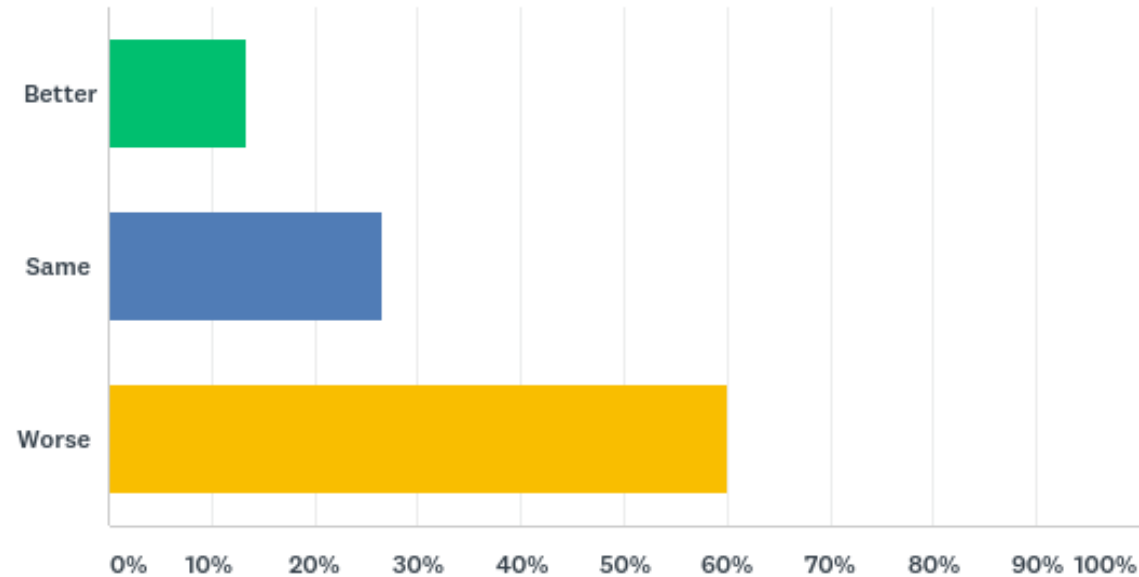
- The survey had 37 respondents (25% of 149 possible)

Respondents

- 76% providers with under 50% Indigenous boarders
 - 64% under 25%
- 24% providers with over 50% Indigenous boarders

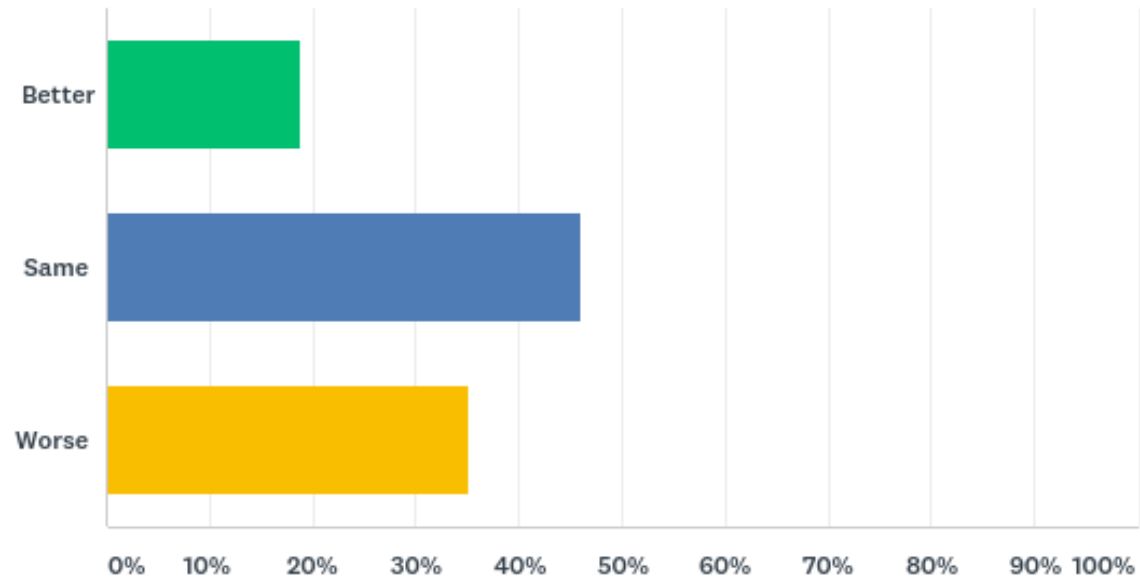
Financial Position 3 year trend (All Respondents)

Q2 Is your boarding operations 2017 financial position better, the same or worse than three years ago?



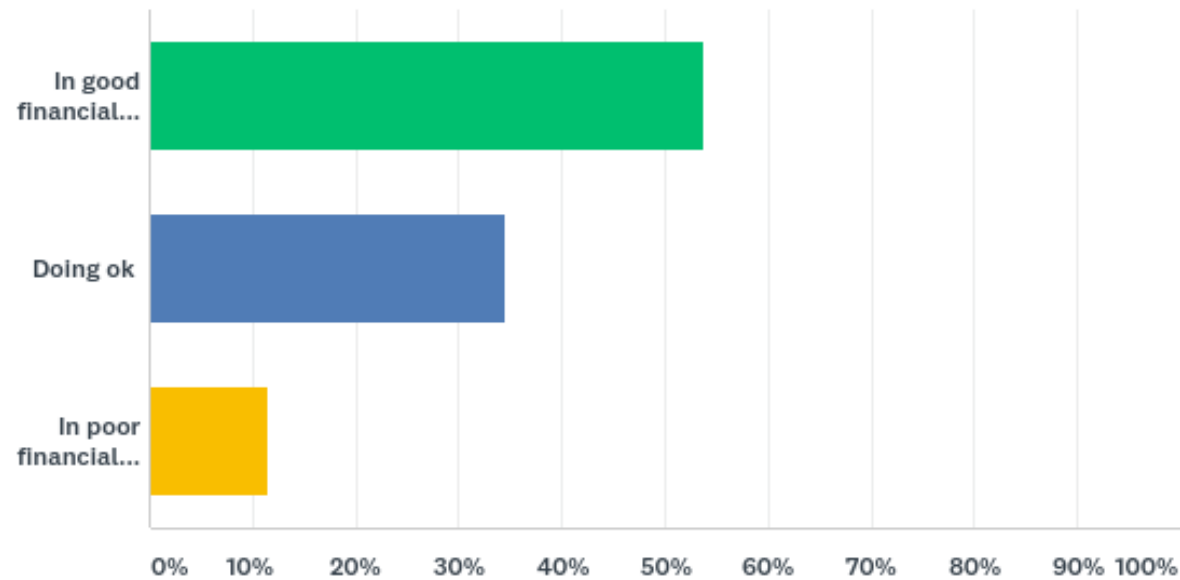
Financial Position 2018 (All Respondents)

Q3 Is your boarding operations 2018 financial position better, same or worse than last year (2017)?



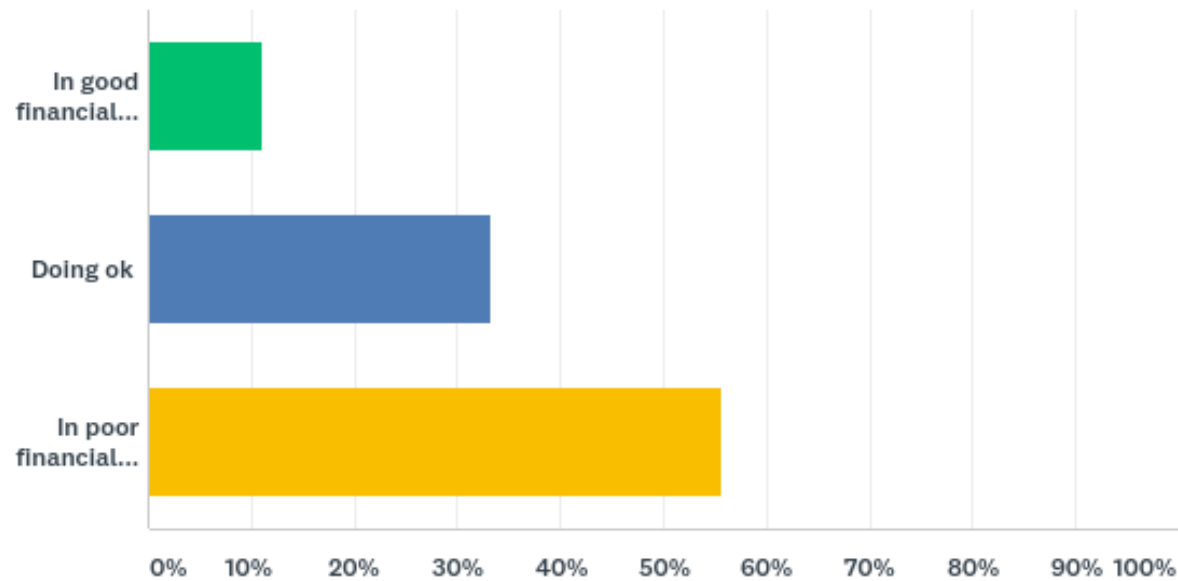
FINANCIAL HEALTH (Under 50%)

Q2 How would you rate the current financial health of your boarding operations?



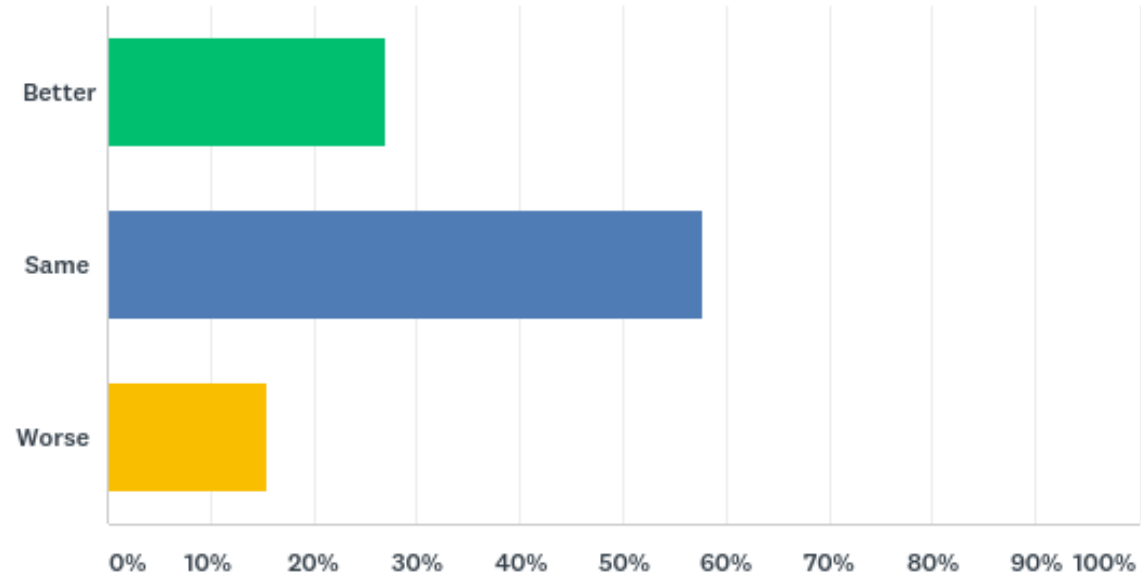
FINANCIAL HEALTH (Over 50%)

Q2 How would you rate the current financial health of your boarding operations?



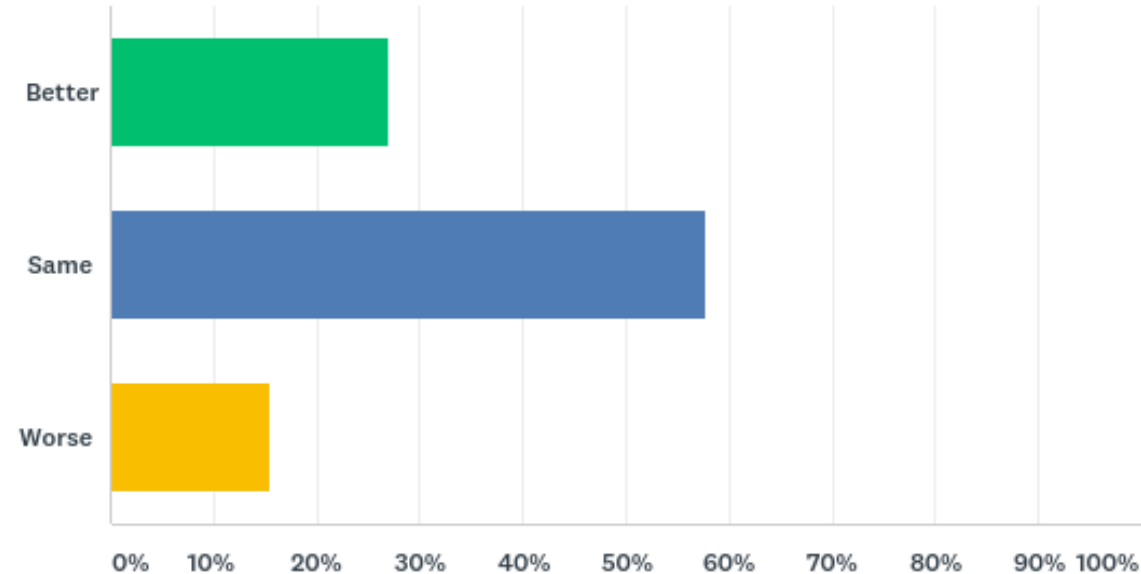
2019 Forecast (Under 50%)

Q5 Will your 2019 financial budget forecasts result in a better, same or worse financial outcome than this year (2018)?



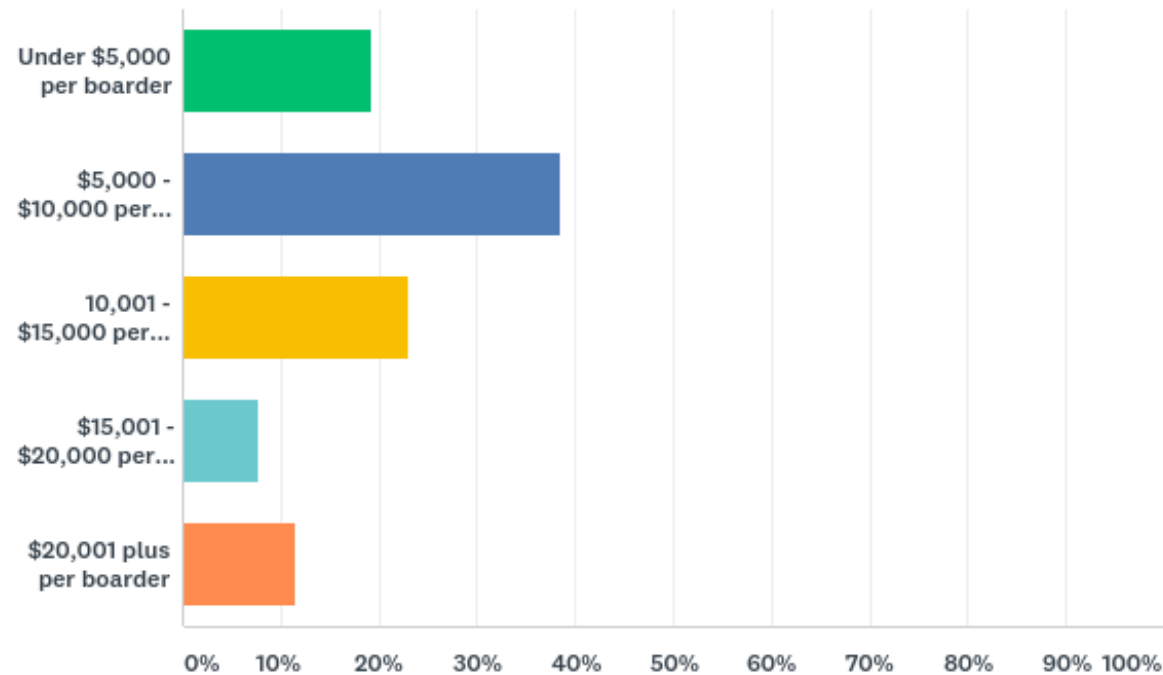

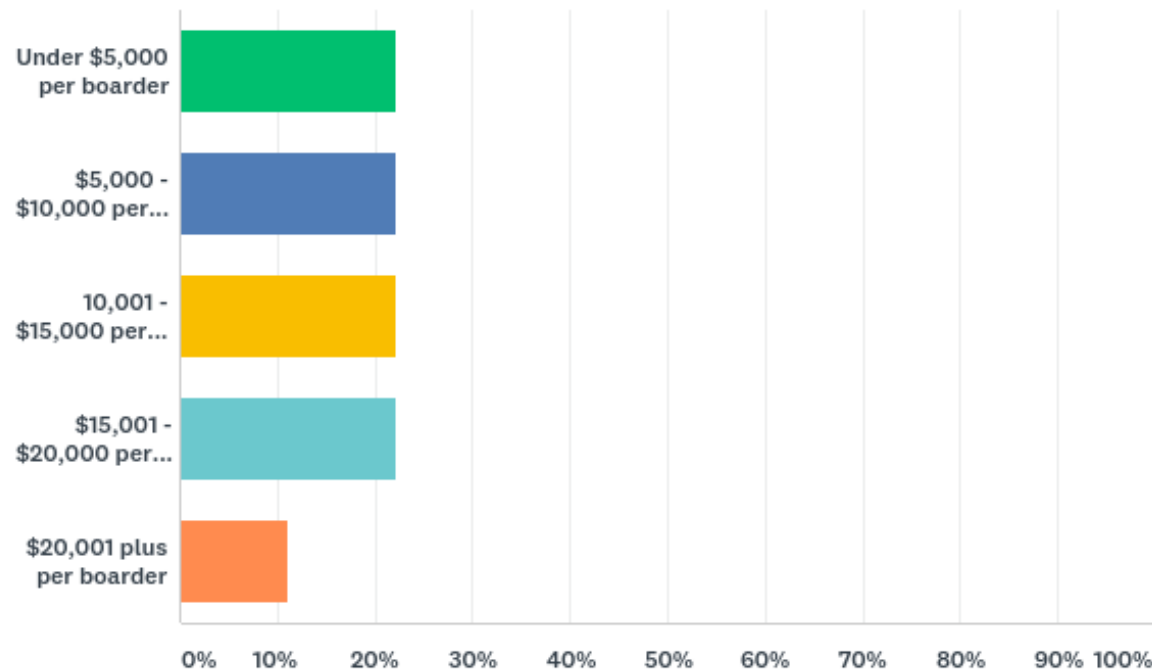

Q8 What is the average amount of ABSTUDY you receive per Indigenous boarder?



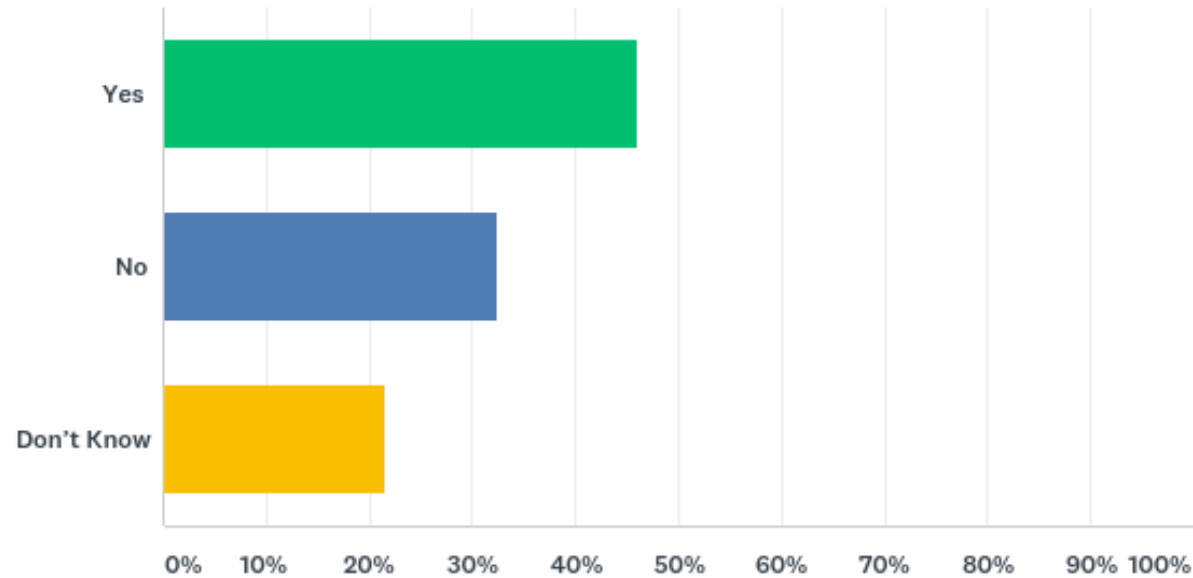

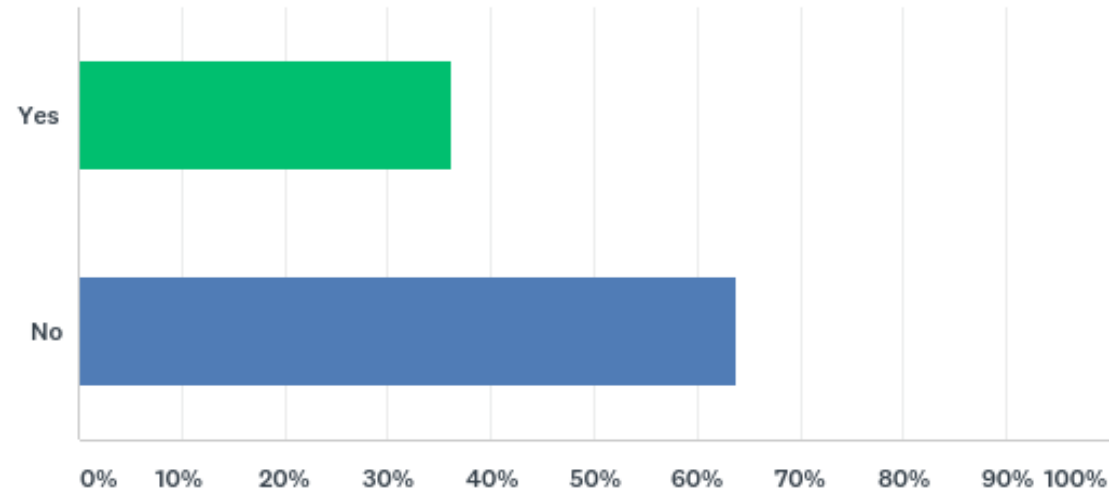

Q9 Do you think your boarding operation is receiving the full entitlement of ABSTUDY?



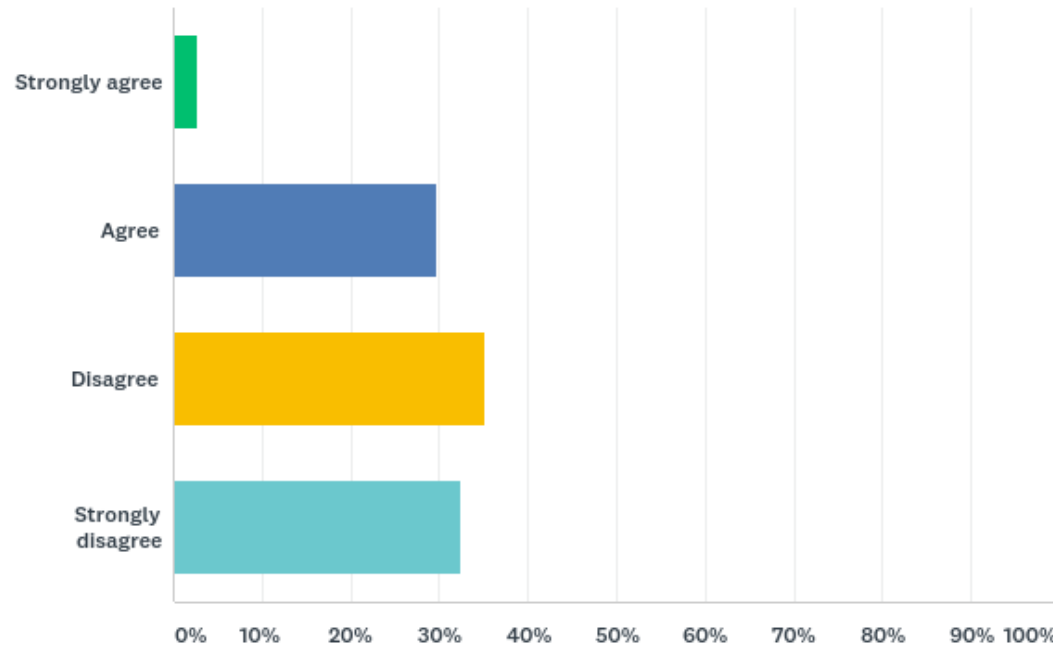
Fee Setting (All respondents)

Q10 Do you take into account the maximum ABSTUDY entitlement when setting your school boarding fees?



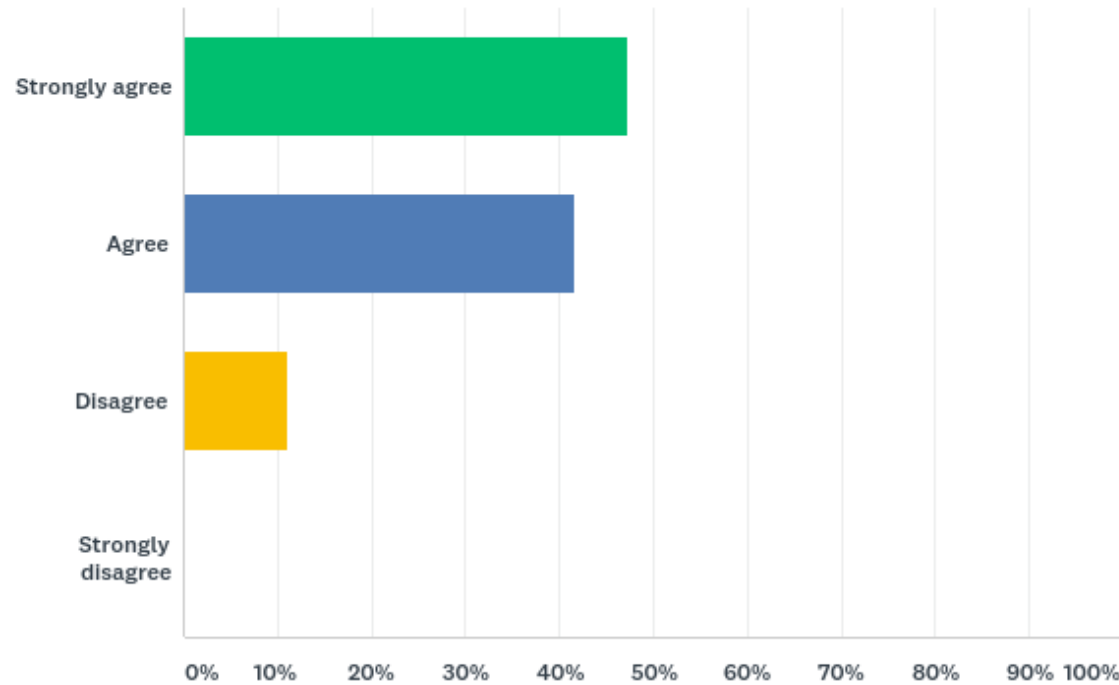

ABSTUDY funding arrangements are well understood



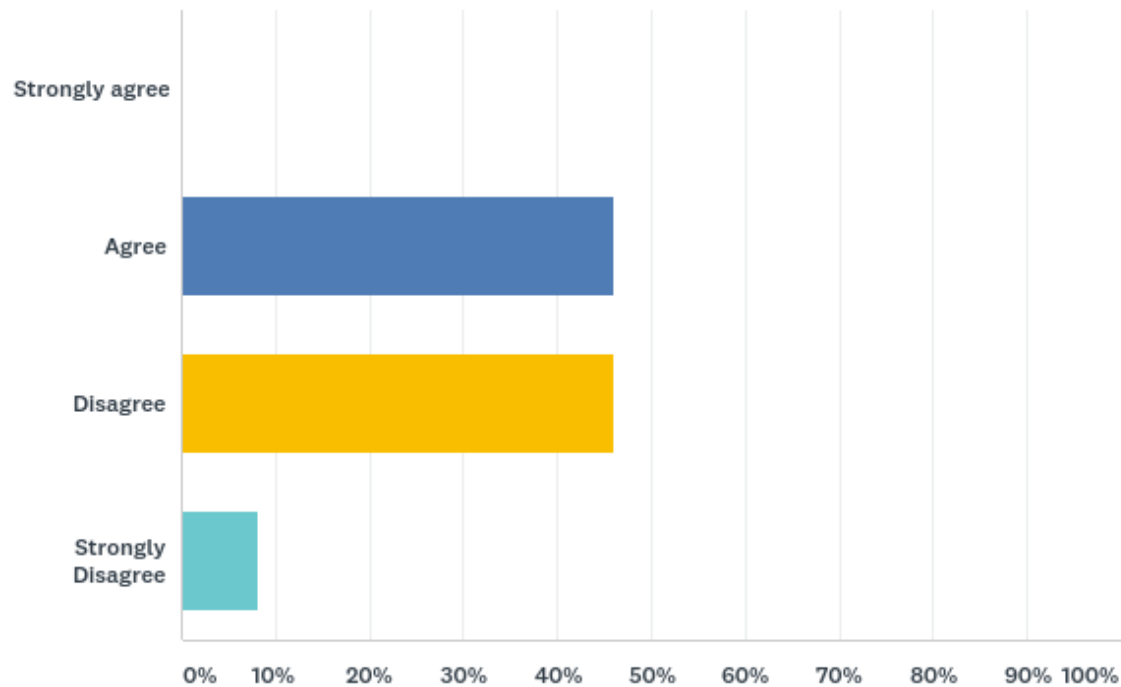
ABSTUDY Administration (All respondents)

Q16 ABSTUDY is administratively overly complicated



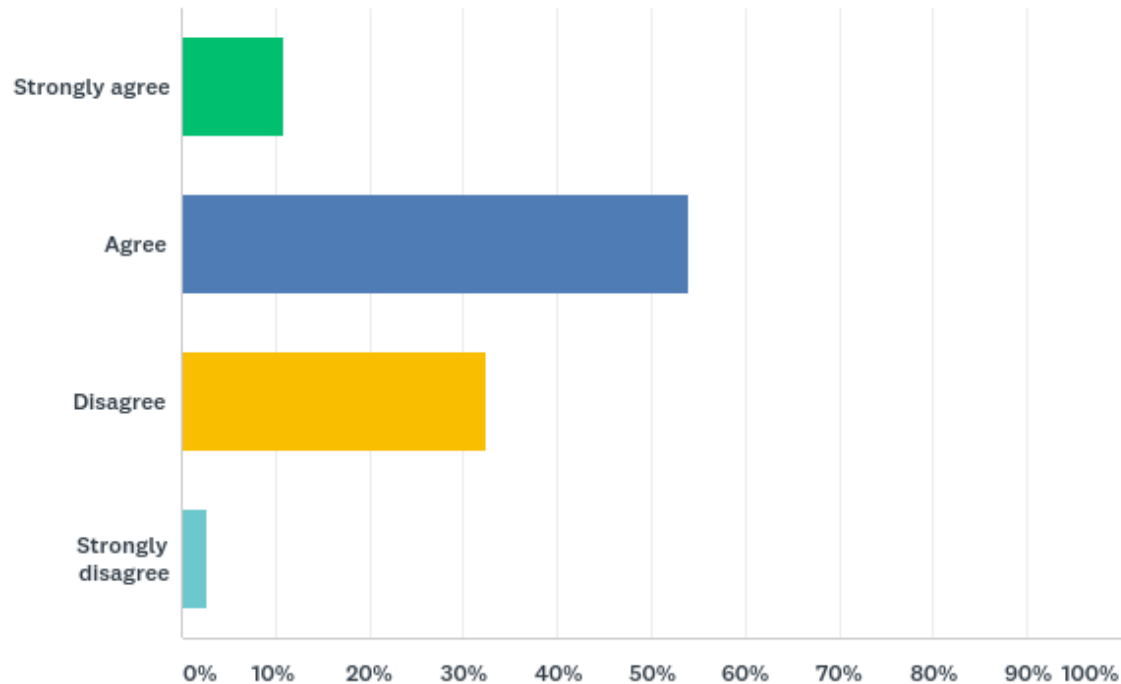

Q17 We have the resources and skills required to maximise the ABSTUDY system



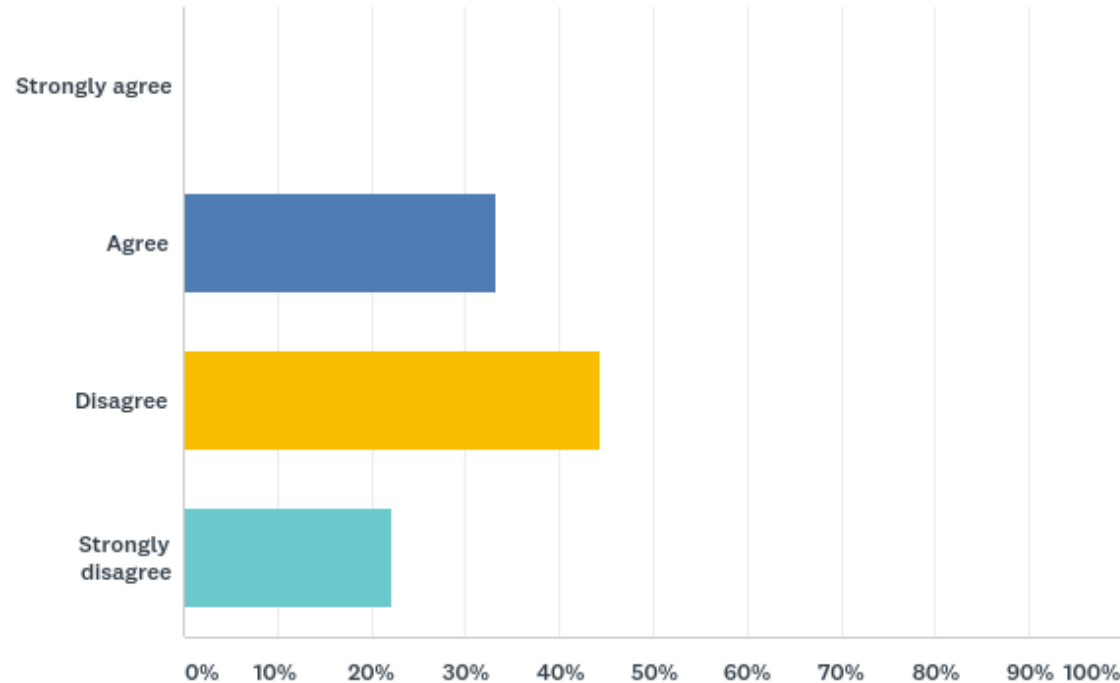

Q18 We have the financial and administrative systems to fully administer ABSTUDY



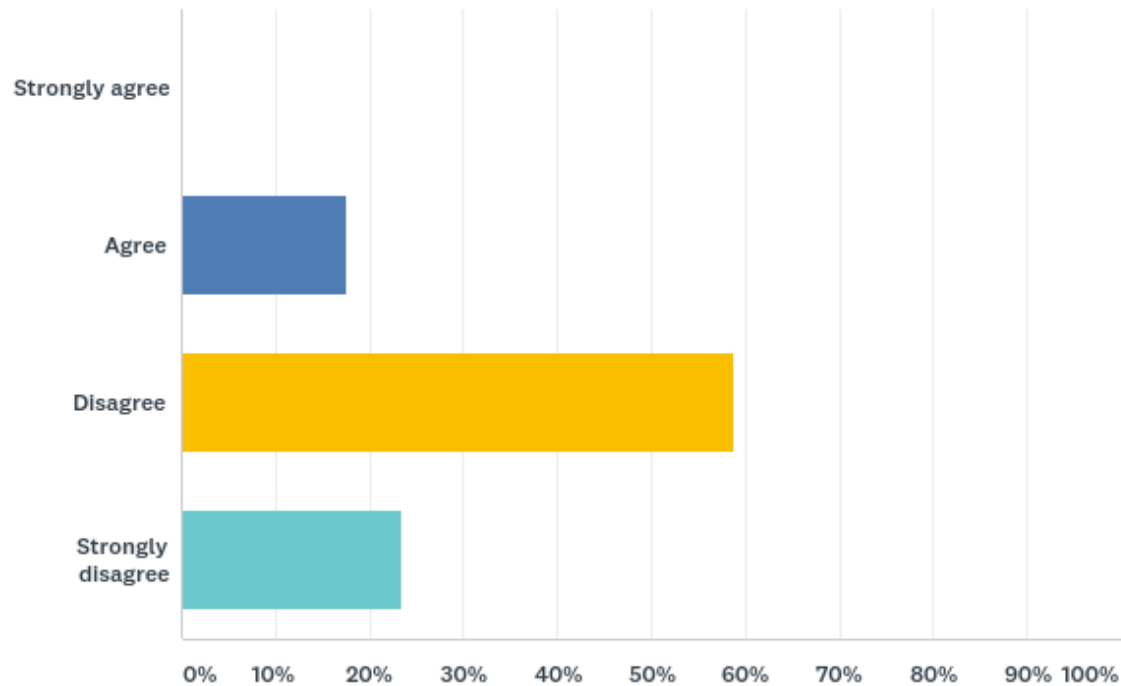
ABSTUDY Transition Funding (All respondents)

Q19 ABSTUDY adequately funds Indigenous student boarding entry transition



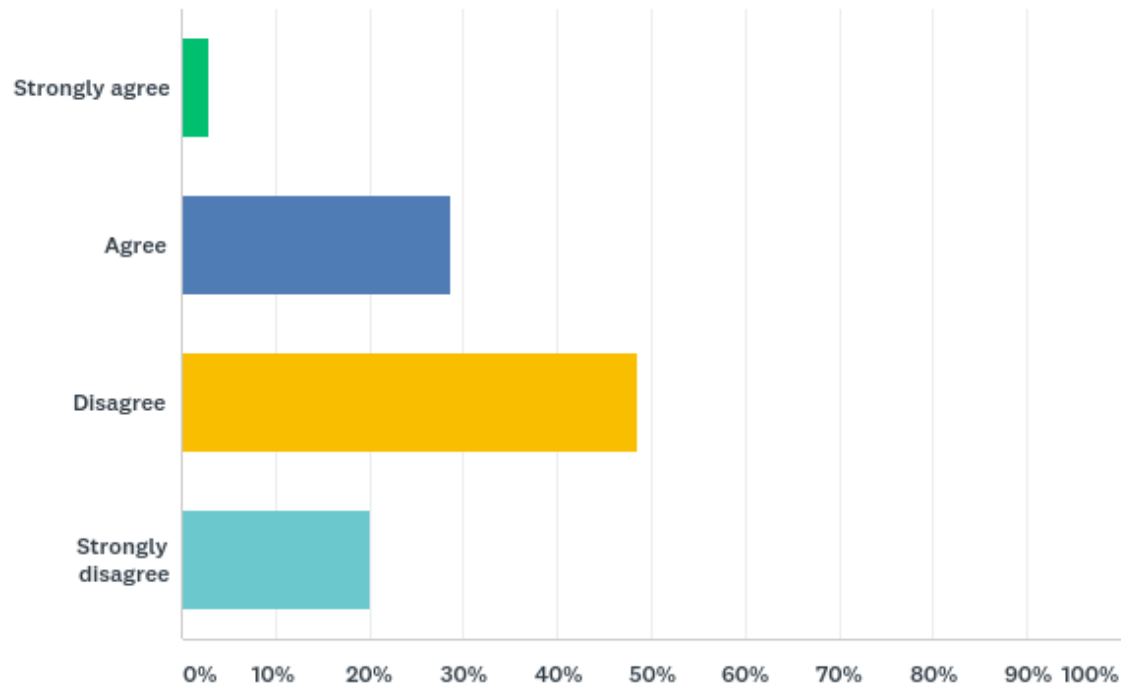

Q20 ABSTUDY adequately funds effective family and community engagement



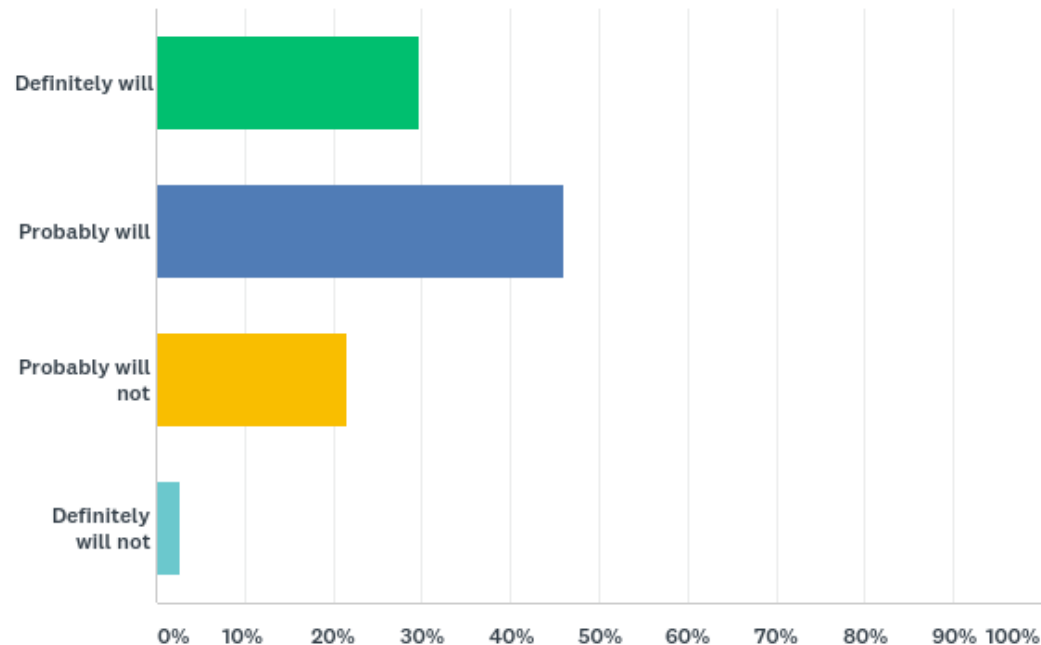
